Yellow Ribbon Award for Veterans Enrolling in the Graduate MSRED Program at the MIT Center for Real Estate

The Center for Real Estate is proud to participate in the Yellow Ribbon program, and seeks the applications of qualified veterans into its Masters in Science in Real Estate Development (MSRED) Degree. <https://mitcre.mit.edu/masters-program/about-the-program>

The [Yellow Ribbon GI Education Enhancement Program](#) (Yellow Ribbon Program) is a provision of the Post-9/11 GI Bill that allows veterans to attend private schools and graduate programs costing more than the state tuition cap. Under the program, participating colleges and universities must offer a veterans-only scholarship which the VA will then match up to the full cost of tuition and fees.

The Yellow Ribbon Award is granted on a first-come, first-served basis. Students must be eligible for the Yellow Ribbon Program as outlined by the Veterans Affairs (VA) and students must exhaust their annual tuition benefit before they are eligible for the Yellow Ribbon Program.

The MSRED Program at the Center for Real Estate will match funds a student receives as part of the Yellow Ribbon Program up to \$25,000 (for a total of **\$50,000 USD** received by the student with the matching amount from the VA).

Each year, one eligible admitted MSRED student identifying as a US Veteran will be able to take advantage of this opportunity. If you are interested in this opportunity, please indicate your veteran status on your online application.
